

Privacy Policy

This privacy notice discloses the privacy practices for the web site www.bbbsofbc.org. This privacy notice applies directly to information collected by this web site. It will notify you of the following:

Security

We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline.

Wherever we collect sensitive information, that information is encrypted and sent to us in a secure manner. You can verify this by looking for the lock icon on the address bar and looking for the "https" at the beginning of the address on the web page.

While we use encryption to protect sensitive information collected online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job, or follow through with further communications with you are granted access to personally identifiable information about you. Computers which store sensitive information are kept in a secure environment.
